

Out with the old in with the new - a guide to currently available grants and schemes

The DEFRA Agricultural Transition Plan has started. 2021 marks the first year of phasing out the Basic Payment Scheme, which will have gone in its entirety by 2028. It is being replaced by a range of grants and schemes to help farmers adapt to the loss of what, for many, is a key income stream.

These new grants and schemes are coming from many sources. To help you navigate through what are currently available and what are coming on stream over the next couple of years we have compiled a fact sheet. It is available [here](#) and is broken down into:
